


Parent's Progress Evening: Thursday 11th October 2p.m -6p.m


FOSM EVENTS

School Website/ Phone App

From the start of new Academic Year September 2018, newsletters and other forms of communication to you will be on the website and phone app mainly. The school will be sending out as little paper copies as possible. Please ensure you have downloaded the school phone app and check the website: as from September we will not be renewing the parent mail text service.

Teachers will be placing more work/homework on their class pages on the website for the children to do, but may need to send some paper copies. Please send the school any updated phone numbers for contact. It is particularly important to download the app, as we can notify you about any changes to clubs or collecting children.

Newsletters are always on the website.

How do I find St Mary's School phone app?

For iOS users:

To find the app in the App Store/ google play, simply search for **School Jotter** and download the app powered by Webanywhere. You might also want to use this link: https://apple.co/2oGDD64 When you open the app, simply search for you school in the top search box typing in the school's postcode **LE11 5AX**. Then select your school from the list.

Once you have chosen the school, it will always load first when opening the app. There may be a delay on some older models of phones.

If you have any difficulties please let us know, you can collect the guide from the school office or we can help you if you bring your phone in.



Administering Medication in school

If your child needs to have medicine administered by school staff during the school day, the medication request form must be completed first. These are available from the school office. We can only administer medicine, if it is prescribed by the health professional and it is accompanied by the professional note or this is clearly stated on the medicine. For the safety of all children please do not send the medicine in with the child. It must be given to the school office with the medication, where it will be locked in our first aid cupboard in the first aid room. Thank you for your support.

School Dinners Payment

The new Academy we belong to Thomas Aquinas MAT, are looking to set up a cashless system for taking in payments for all 22 schools in the Academy. It would be great to have parental ideas on this.
